BRITISH COLUMBIA HEALTH REGULATIONS

CEC Event affected: NACS Richmond (Lead & Speed), October 8-10, 2021

- People aged 12 and older will have to show proof of vaccination in British Columbia starting September 13, 2021. The requirement is in place until Jan. 31, 2022, subject to extension.
 - By Sept. 13, people aged 12 and older will be required to show proof of one dose of vaccine
 - By Oct. 24, people aged 12 and older will be required to be fully vaccinated at least seven days after receiving second dose
- British Columbia has one of the strongest vaccination rates in Canada with 75% of eligible people now fully vaccinated
- How? Proof of vaccination and valid government ID
- People from other Canadian provinces or territories must show a provincially/territorially officially recognized vaccine record as well as valid government ID from the same province or territory.
- International visitors must show the proof of vaccination they used to enter Canada with their passport.




