ROUTE SETTER - NORTH AMERICAN CUP SERIES

CEC is now accepting applications for the positions of Routesetter at each of the 2 Canadian stops of the 2021 North American Cup Series. We will be looking to hire a minimum of one female for each event and a total of:

- Kanata 4 setters
- Richmond 2 setters

REQUIREMENTS

According to the <u>CEC Screening Policy</u>, the Routesetter positions are ranked "Level 2 - Medium Risk" positions. Therefore, the following requirements must be completed prior to performing the duties at the event:

- 1. Have a valid CEC License
- 2. Complete the online CEC Volunteer Registration Form when requested by CEC
- 3. Provide an Enhanced Police Information Check (E-PIC) when invited to do so by CEC
- 4. Safe Sport & Ethics Training
 - a. Respect in Sport (contact CEC for a free access code); OR
 - b. CAC Safe Sport Training
- 5. Concussion Awareness training NCCP Making Head Way in Sport
- 6. CEC Concussion Education Sheet
- 7. Read and remain up to date on all CEC and IFSC rules and regulations.

ROUTESETTER

JOB DESCRIPTION

Under the direction of the Chief Routesetter and the Assistant Chief Routesetter, the Route Setter is responsible for:

- Installation, forerunning and maintenance of boulders and/or routes.
- Communication and collaboration with other setters and officials.

EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS

EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS

- Previous experience as CEC route setter or equivalent.
- Ability to work well with a team.
- Knowledge of competitor field for event(s) applied for.
- Ability to climb on all boulders and/or routes for event(s) applied for.

For Richmond only:

- Experience setting on a lift.
- Experience setting on 12+ meter walls.

COMPENSATION

The Routesetter is expected to be present between 2-4 days in advance of the competition depending on facility logistics

Compensation includes:

- Accommodation for the duration of the contract.
- contract fee for the length of event as follows:
 - Kanata = \$800.00 CAD
 - o Richmond = \$1,000.00 CAD

Successful Applicants will be responsible for their own travel.

The selection committee will review all applications for Route Setter positions using the following criteria in order of importance:

First Priority Criteria

- 1. National setting experience
 - a. In any setting position
- 2. Provincial setting experience
 - a. Previous experience as Head Setter
 - b. 5 experiences as assistant Head Routesetter
- 3. Other competition experience, setting and competing

Second Priority Criteria

- 1. Potential for growth as a Routesetter
- 2. Canadian Resident or Citizen, located in Canada
- 3. Proximity to the event host facility

Successful candidates will be notified by the end of August 9, 2021.
