DESCRIPTION

Climbing Escalade Canada (CEC) is seeking up to 4 qualified individuals for the roles of Assistant Coaches / Chaperones for the 2022 Youth World Championships. Reporting to the Youth National Coaches (Men's and Women's Team), the Assistant Coaches / Chaperones will be responsible the duties and responsibilities outlined below during the 2022 Youth World Championships to be held August 22-31 in Dallas, USA.

There are up to 4 Assistant Coaches and Chaperones positions available, depending on final team size.

Priority for these positions will be given to applicants who meet all the below requirements. That being said, it is possible that candidates who meet only the Chaperone requirements be considered for such role.

JOB DESCRIPTION – Assistant Coach

- Under the direction the Youth National Coaches and the Team Manager, carry out the athlete support and logistics and performance plans:
 - o Pre-competition travel chaperone duties (up to 6 athletes per coach)
 - o Daily chaperone duties as assigned by the Team Manager including:
 - Nightly bed checks
 - Daily logistics support
 - o Daily Coaching duties as assigned by the Youth National Coaches, including:
 - In Competition athlete support during
 - Training days (if possible)
 - Event days
 - Athlete performance tracking
 - De-briefs and Team meetings

JOB DESCRIPTION – Chaperone Only

- Under the direction the Youth National Coaches and the Team Manager carry out the athlete support and logistics.
 - o Pre-competition travel chaperone duties (up to 6 athletes per coach)
 - o Daily chaperone duties as assigned by the Team Manager including:
 - Nightly bed checks
 - Daily logistics support

- Registration with The Locker and completion of NCCP Multi-Sport trainings (candidate is expected to provide copy of their Certification Transcript) OR equivalent from another national organization
- Knowledge of Long-Term Athlete Development framework considered a strong asset
- Bilingualism (English, French) with excellent spoken and written skills in both languages is an asset
- Knowledge of Safe Sport Travel with Youth Athletes guidelines and best practices
