## Housekeeping

As required:

- Parking information - Reserved Hive spots or paid spots only.
- Waivers - Required for all athletes and coaches, recommended for spectators as well. Fill this out tonight! You cannot climb if you do not have a valid waiver, anyone under 18 must have this signed by their legal guardian.
- Spectators - Space will be very limited for qualification - we ask that you are only in the gym while your athletes climb, and that you leave to ensure others have space to watch.
- Start lists will be posted both in the warm-up area and at the dedicated results board in the foyer at the hive, as well as results as they come.
- Final Schedule can be found on the CEC website. Please check for updates. Please only show up to the gym for your designated time, athletes will not be permitted in the gym unless they are climbing
- Event Central will be updated with final results as they come
- The annual Vaisakhi parade takes place in Surrey tomorrow. While the parade route and road closures are well south of The Hive, the parade is expected to draw up to half-a-million people (depending on weather) so it may impact bridge traffic, public transport and roads to the south of our event. The parade route begins at Gurdwara Dashmesh Darbar (12885 85th Avenue) and travels along 124 Street, turns left onto 75 Avenue, continues on 76 Avenue, and onto 128 Street before returning to the temple.
  - **Traffic controls will start at 6am and last until approximately 8pm.**
  - Access to 128 Street and road sections along the parade route will be impacted most significantly. Increased delays may be expected for travel through and within the area between 72 Avenue to 88 Avenue, and Scott Road to King George Boulevard. **Please plan your routes accordingly.**

## **Competition**

- Only already approved coaches will be allowed in the competition area.
- General
  - Participants can move freely in the competition area until their time to report to the marshaling area (10 minutes prior to their start)
  - Staging areas Problems 1,2 and 3 located beside the warm-up area.
  - Staging areas for problems for 4, 5 and 6 middle of the gym in the hangboard area.
- Final IFSC Onsite Format:
  - 10 competitors per category to finals.
  - ISO for finals with all IFSC ISO rules in effect.
- Appeals are 75\$, use written form stating the rule number from IFSC rules 1.7.6 (11/5/2021). Appeals can be written in English or French.
  - Appeals can be made up to five minutes after the provisional results have been posted (at the designated results board).
- There will be two marshaling chairs in the staging area.

- Awards will be presented in the front foyer after finals.
